

**FEDERAL STUDENTS RIGHT TO KNOW ACT
GRADUATION/COMPLETION RATES 2019**

The Student Right-to-Know Act, passed by Congress in 1990, requires institutions eligible for Title IV funding, under the Higher Education Act of 1965, to calculate completion or graduation rates of certificate- or degree-seeking, full-time students entering that institution, and to disclose these rates to current and prospective students.

The following completion/graduation-rate information is listed in compliance with the Federal Right-to-Know Act, Section 103 and includes full-time, first-time students who have graduated within 150% of the length of their program.

These rates are the completion/graduation-rate data reported by *Modern Technology School*, August 31, 2018 immediately following the 12-month period; during which 150% of the normal time for completion or graduation has elapsed for all student in the group which the institution bases its completion or graduation rates (as defined in IPEDS). The School has no transfer out rates. Full year cohort used from IPEDS September 1, 2015 – August 31, 2016.
